Rules for the Show:

- Open to the world
- Ewe and Wether lambs are eligible-maximum of three lambs per exhibitor
- Lambs cannot show in more than one age division
- There will be three show age divisions (age day of show):
 - Juniors – 12 and under
 - Intermediates – 13 to 15
 - Seniors – 16 to 18
- Three breed characteristic divisions will be shown in the following manner:
 - Minor breeds (Southdown, Dorsets and Speckles)
 - Black-faced white pelted (Shropshire, Hampshire and Suffolks)
 - Black-faced black pelted (Natural Colored)
- All classes will be broken by official weigh-in weights
- Limited Pen Space – most exhibitors will have to show out of the trailer
- No painting or altering of color will be allowed
